If you enjoy history or just want to bask in the coastal beauty of Florida & Georgia, this custom planned tour will be a delightful getaway with old & new travel partners in the Peoples Bank VItOP Club.

Friday, May 1—Our deluxe motorcoach with all the bells & whistles will depart south. A lite breakfast and, of course, snacks & water will be served as we travel. We will take the Original Chocolate tour to taste artisan chocolates after visiting the Mission of Nombte de Dios, the landing site of the Founder of the city where the first Catholic Mass was held in the new world. Overnight at your hotel located right on Vilano Beach and enjoy dinner with entrée choices followed by entertainment that incorporates history, laughter and audience participation. (B, D)

Sunday, May 3 — Depart for the Golden Isles where a local guide will join us for a Tram Tour of Jekyll Island, the gilded era island retreat for the empire builders who shaped our Nation's future. The Jekyll Island Club, still a renowned lodging choice, will be our site for an included lunch and tour of the hotel. We will transfer to lovely St. Simon Island for a driving tour as moss-covered oaks and ocean breezes weave past and present together. Our guide will narrate delightful stories that range through the Colonial Era to the Plantation Era to the elegant present day Resort Era. John & Charles Wesley were colorful inhabitants of the island, and still standing is the historic Christ Church. We will reach Savannah for a two night stay in our hotel in the Historic District where you can walk to dining establishments in the area. The evening is free to enjoy the city's vibrant night life or just relax in your newly renovated lodging. (B,L)

Monday, May 4 \_ Meet our guide at the Savannah Visitor's Center and spend some time in the Savannah History Museum showcasing everything from a 1902 Crestmobile that predates the Ford Model A to Johnny Mercer's Oscar & Grammy Awards. Or maybe you want to know more about the filming of *Forrest Gump*! We will board a trolley that allows us on/off boarding privileges at 13 different stops. Make your choice—unique shops & boutiques or points of interest like the Cathedral of St John the Baptist. Lunch is on your own followed by a tour of the Davenport House completed circa 1820 and includes accurate wallpaper & furnishings reflecting the inventory taken at the time of Davenport's death in 1827. Gift Shop!!! Tonight is a memorable experience as we board a beautiful riverboat for a gospel dinner cruise. One of the best black gospel choirs in the Low country will be entertaining us with the uplifting sounds of "southern" gospel. A bountiful buffet will serve up classic dishes of the south. (B, D)

Tuesday, May 5 — following breakfast at our hotel, we will head home to Tennessee.
